# Emergency Response Information

IN CASE OF EMERGENCY FOLLOW THIS GENERAL GUIDE ACTIONS:

1. IMMEDIATELY STOP THE VEHICLE WHERE SAFE TO DO SO
2. MOVE YOURSELF TO A SAFE AREA WITHOUT LEAVING THE SITE UNATTENDED

This includes:

- Assessing the situation
- Checking for any damage to the load
- Checking for injuries
- Retrieve your DG Documentation located inside the driver's door and your mobile phone in case you need to contact Emergency Services.

**DO NOT HANDLE THE DANGEROUS GOODS UNLESS YOU HAVE SPECIFIC PRODUCT KNOWLEDGE AND THE CORRECT EQUIPMENT TO DO SO WITHOUT RISK TO YOU AND OTHERS**

3. IN CASE OF AN EMERGENCY INVOLVING FIRE OR SPILLAGE OF ANY DG IMMEDIATELY DIAL 111 FOR FIRE OR POLICE.

If unable to dial 111, ask bystander to relay the message to Emergency Services on your behalf by providing them with information below.

**RELAY TO EMERGENCY SERVICES:**

- LOCATION OF THE INCIDENT: Use your mobile phone GPS for precise location identification or use landmarks such as bridge markings etc.
- DETAILS OF INCIDENT INCLUDING ANY INJURIES:  
What happened?      Number of casualties?      What has been done?
- Details about your load and DG carried found in Dangerous Goods Declaration:
  - Proper Shipping name of each Dangerous Goods
    - UN numbers of each Dangerous Goods
    - Classes of each Dangerous Goods
    - Quantities of each Dangerous Goods
  - Any emergency phone numbers listed on the declaration

**EMERGENCY SERVICES MAY PROVIDE INSTRUCTIONS OVER THE PHONE IF NOT, THE FOLLOWING STEPS MUST BE TAKEN:**

4. CLEAR THE AREA AND ISOLATE THE SITE:

Put on any Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) available in your vehicle if necessary.  
Evacuate the area if needed to a safe location.

**Always consider evacuating upwind or uphill**

5. MAINTAIN CONTROL OVER THE SITE: Ask bystanders and nearby individuals to help
6. WAIT AT A SAFE DISTANCE UNTIL THE EMERGENCY SERVICES ARRIVE.

**ONCE EMERGENCY SERVICES ARRIVE:**

- Make yourself known to Emergency Services and adhere to all instructions provided
- Give to Emergency Services DG Documents and Emergency Procedure Guide
