All Other Dangerous Goods

When Transporting Dangerous UN3480 as “**SolarZero Contractor**” you must comply with all rules and regulations prescribed in Land Transport Rule: Dangerous Goods 2005.

Packaging (\$1500)	Must comply with General Packing requirements. Must be suitable for type and quantity, robust in good conditions. DO NOT TRANSPORT IF DAMAGED	
Marking and Labelling (\$2000)	Must have: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Primary and, If applicable, Subsidiary Class Labels - Proper Shipping Name and UN Number - Any packaging or special information markings required by the rule or other legislations <i>All Labels and Markings must be clear, visible and durable to withstand normal transport conditions.</i>	
Segregation (\$1000)	Required. MUST NOT BE LOADED IN THE SAME VEHICLE WITH CLASS 1 EXPLOSIVES.	
Placarding (\$1500)	Required if over 50kg/litres. Must use Dangerous Goods Placard or Class 9 placard ON FRONT AND REAR OF VEHICLE OR COMBINATION VEHICLE. MUST REMOVE PLACARDS ONCE NO DG ON VEHICLE  Or 	
Documentation (Must be kept inside DG document Holder inside driver's door) (up to \$2000)	DG Declaration	Required. <u>Must enter following information to Declaration:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - <i>Number & Kind of Packages</i> - <i>Gross Weight and Volume</i> - <i>Receiver / Consignee Name & Address & Phone Number</i> - <i>Date at the bottom of DG Declaration</i>
	ERI (Emergency Response Information)	Required. Located on the back of Dangerous Goods Declaration Please read and be familiar with ERI procedures
	Schedule of Quantities	Required when transporting UN3480 Lithium Batteries to multiple Customers in the same vehicle. MUST BE FILLED IN BEFORE DEPARTURE AND ADJUSTED DUE TO PICK UP OR DELIVERY OF ANY DGS ON LOAD
Load Security (\$750)	Dangerous Goods loaded on a vehicle must be secured: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - <i>to maintain segregation distances;</i> - <i>withstand acceleration and deceleration that occurs during normal conditions of transport;</i> - <i>to prevent loss or damage to dangerous goods</i> 	
Training (up to \$900)	Must be aware of: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - <i>The hazard associated with dangerous goods carried in a vehicle</i> - <i>Safe practices while transporting Dangerous Goods on a vehicle</i> - <i>Emergency Procedures found in Emergency Response Information or DG Declaration</i> - MUST HAVE D ENDORSEMENT ON THE LICENCE unless under the direct supervision of a person with a current D endorsement 	
Transport Procedures (\$500)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - <i>Complying with all parking restrictions. Do not park a vehicle carrying dangerous goods for more than 18 hours outside a depot</i>
